
I hope you are as excited as I am to see what God might do in us and through us as we grow deeper in him, his love, and his grace.

# Orangevale Seventh Day Adventist Church offered a visit to biblical times with the "Day in Bethlehem" event on Sabbath, December 20<sup>th</sup>. The re-enactment of happenings on the streets of Bethlehem around the time that Jesus was born, included tradesmen (and women) dressed in time-appropriate costumes telling each group of visitors about their day to day life in

Bethlehem. The street stations offered hands on demonstrations and skills common to the day.

- While visiting Bethlehem, visitors experienced:A complimentary breakfast to start off the experience.
- Registration to enter the city by live "innkeepers".
- A visit to our Bethlehem oil merchant to learn about Frankincense and other time period oils.
- Meeting with a shepherd, bearing the wonderful news that Christ the Savior is born while guiding groups through the Bethlehem experience.
- Interaction with the Bethlehem town Physician and midwives to learn about the importance of swaddling to infant health.
- Witnessing two local fisherpeople discussing their trade and how everything is connected to Jesus' birth.
- Exploring the art of candle making with two local artisans and how "light" is important to our relationship with Jesus.
- Learning a new Zion song to experience music of that time period.
- Exposure to Greek writings by the prophets and scribes and learning different names for "Jesus".
- Witnessing bread making from two local bakers of the time and experiencing a "tasting" sample.
- Learning how to tie a knot from stable masters, similar to the knot on Mary's donkey and what it symbolizes.
- Encountering a tax collector seen at the conclusion of the event collecting plastic coins ("taxes").
- Culminating with a worship experience which included an interview with the pregnant Mary, special music features, and a powerful Bethlehem message by Pastor Jon.
- Hot soup, salad, and bread lunch to end the experience

Mt 2:1 After JESUS was born in BETHLEHEM in Judea, during the time of King Herod, Magi from the east came to Jerusalem. (Lk 2:4-7)

#### <u>Time of Birth</u>

Da 9:25 Know and understand this: From the issuing of the decree to restore and rebuild Jerusalem until the ANOINTED ONE, the ruler, comes, there will be seven "sevens" and sixty-two "sevens." It will be rebuild with streets and a trench, but in times of trouble.

Lk 2:1-2 In those days Caesar Augustus issued a decree that a census should be taken of the entire Roman world. (This was the first census that took place while Quirinius was governor of Syria.) (Lk 2:3-7)

#### <u>Born of a Virgin</u>

Isa 7:14 Therefore the LORD himself will give you a sign: The virgin will be with child and will give birth to a son, and will call him IMMANUEL.

Mt 1:18 This is how the birth of JESUS CHRIST came about: his other Mary was pledged to be married to Joseph, but before they came together, she was found to be with child through the HOLY SPIRIT. (Lk 1:26-35)






